
# A Pirate's Life is a Colorful Life!





## THE GREAT WHITE SHARK

is a fascinating ocean creature that can grow up to 26 feet long and weigh between 2,000 and 5,000 pounds. They swim gracefully at speeds of 15 to 25 mph and have over 300 teeth, making them formidable hunters. Their remarkable senses, including the ability to detect electromagnetic fields, aid in hunting. Great whites are often found in the warmer, shallower coastal waters. Nature is truly wonderful!




## THE KRAKEN

is a legendary giant squid known for its long tentacles and unique boneless structure. These fascinating creatures can grow up to 30 to 40 feet long and weigh around 600 pounds! With impressive swimming abilities, they use jet propulsion for agility. When threatened, they release dark ink to escape unnoticed. Equipped with razor-sharp teeth and a strong beak, The Kraken can create suction forces of at least 100 pounds per square inch. Typically found at depths of hundreds to thousands of feet, The Kraken highlights the incredible mysteries of life in the ocean.
